The New York Post and Michelle Gottself are pleased to announce today that they have amicably resolved the lawsuit filed by Ms. Gottself in federal court in January 2022, and that the lawsuit will be withdrawn against all parties.

Launched in November 1801 by Alexander Hamilton, the New York Post is the oldest continuously published daily newspaper in the United States.

The agreement between The Post and Ms. Gottself followed a month of discussions, and the announcement comes in accordance with the expiration of the twenty-one-day statutory waiting period.
